A recent example

We were recommended by the B3 Housing Association that a young lady had just been housed by them in Hoddesdon from Tottenham was living on benefits and unemployed, she was interested in a caring role could we help her ?

We offered as a volunteer carer to follow me on every request I had and to gain experience of care needs. After 3 weeks of visiting care homes ,hospital visits and social clubs she selected a residential care home within a further week had arranged an intervue on a Friday and with our comprehensive CV she was offered a week long course starting on the Monday, our driver’s helped with transport and during the course she was offered a placement at her first choice when a vacancy arose, this has now happened and she starts in the first week of December.

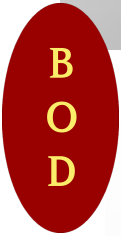
